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- EC assessment: "Limited progress in 2018 CSRs" => challenges ahead
 - Public procurement: still premature to assess the new framework
 - Regulation: implementing Market Unity slowly, no reform of professional services
- Reform priorities:
 - Public procurement (ensure efficiency under the new framework)

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 - Public procurement ensure efficiency under the new framework)
- Recent report (E/CNMC/004/18): open procedure could save 10% (€1.7 billion)
- Training civil (1,600) servants
- Analysis of many tenders and general documents (<u>here</u>)
- In the pipeline: update of the Guide on public procurement & competition (2009)

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 - Public <u>procurement</u> (ensure efficiency under the new framework)
 - Access to finance by SMEs (not so pressing)
- Report on Fintech (E/CNMC/001/18)

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 - Regulation is excessive
 - High restrictions professional services
- Thoroughly assessed (E-2011-04, E-2008-01, IPN 110/13 and many reports)

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 - High restrictions in retail)
- Previously assessed (E-2012-01, E-2003-01, IPN 009/09 & recent court appeals)

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 - Market Unity undermined by procedures & no inter-administrative cooperation
 - Even if CNMC is being very active in appeals See here & he

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 - Private Hire Vehicles
- Recent report, joint statement w/ regional competition authorities & court appeals
- In the pipeline "Urban mobility"

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 - Private Hire Vehicles
 - Burdensome local/regional regime for short-term rentals (appealed by CNMC)
 - Report (2018) & court appeals

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 - Ports, passenger rail in the pipeline
 - Airports (2015) and air-traffic control (2018)

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 - Economic/environmental issues in water >> Sectoral regulator and cost-pricing
 - In the pipeline

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 - Challenges of ultra-peripheric regions
 Some reports on State Aid to transport
 - In the pipeline: rebates for airplane tickets

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 - Improve governance and institutional quality
