

- The Spanish authority dismantled 24 cartels...
- …and imposed sanctions of more than 690 million €
- The CNMC estimates the impact of its enforcement and merger control actions in savings for consumers of 889 million € in 2015 and 861 million € in 2016.



- Is there room for improvement through fine-tunning of National Competition Act and/or ECN+ Directive?






"Hunting, gathering.... It's so hard to *prioritize!*"







- ECN+ proposal sets minimums almost entirely covered by Spanish Competition Act...
- but helpful to reinforce deterrence effects of fines and prioritisation
- Some challenges ahead: vague concepts, Governments' ambition in the transposition of the Directive
