Public Consultation for Complementary Intraday Regional Auctions for the Spanish-Portuguese Bidding Zone Border

In the period between 28th July 2017 and 11th September 2017, the relevant national regulatory authorities CNMC and ERSE open a joint consultation to interested parties on the proposal about the mechanism for Complementary Intraday Regional Auctions for the Spanish-Portuguese Bidding Zone Border, entitled as the "**Operating Proposal for the Intraday Market in MIBEL**", in accordance with Article 63 of the Regulation (EU) 2015/1222 of 24th July 2015 establishing a guideline on capacity allocation and congestion management (Regulation 2015/1222).

This proposal is based on the joint proposal of the NEMO and the Iberian TSOs, released on 14th February, in accordance with Article 63(1) of Regulation 2015/1222.

On 24th April 2017, the NEMO and the Iberian TSOs published the results of the consultation on the "Operating Proposal for the Intraday Market in MIBEL"¹.

CNMC and ERSE, after analysing the proposal of the Intraday Regional Auctions mechanism and taking into account the interested parties' comments on the proposal, agree to initiate a new consultation of the interested parties pursuant to Article 63(4)(e) of the Regulation 2015/1222, requesting the opinion of interested parties on the " Operating Proposal for the Intraday Market in MIBEL".

Following the consultation with the interested parties, the Iberian regulatory authorities CNMC and ERSE will submit a request for amendment to the NEMO and the Iberian TSOs for the review of the proposal in order to be approved by the Iberian regulatory authorities.
