The CNMC initiates disciplinary proceedings against Maquinaria Garrido S.L. for alleged practices prohibited by the Anti-Trust Law.

• It is investigating the possible restriction of passive sales by its official distributors outside its exclusive territory, and the possible fixing of resale prices.

Madrid, 04 November 2020 - The CNMC is investigating Maquinaria Garrido S.L. for alleged practices involving possible restrictions on passive sales, for fixing resale prices and for imposing other commercial conditions on the official distributors of the products it markets under the Topavi brand.

In view of the information collected, the CNMC has decided to initiate these disciplinary proceedings against the company, given the reasonable grounds to suspect an infraction of Article 1 of Law 15/2007 of 3 July, the Anti-Trust Law.

The initiation of these proceedings does not prejudge the final outcome of the investigation. A maximum period of 18 months is now open for the CNMC to investigate and settle the case.
