

The CNMC and the Ecuadorian competition authority (SCE) strengthen their strategic collaboration

- The authorities of both institutions have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

The President of the CNMC, Cani Fernández, and the Superintendent of Economic Competition, Danilo Sylva, have expressed their commitment to continue cooperating for competition advocacy and promotion and for the proper functioning of the Spanish and Ecuadorian markets.

Signing of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

Specifically, this agreement promotes the exchange of experiences and best practices between the two institutions for the enforcement of competition law.
